

## Questions for 1 Peter 1:13-25

1. What does it mean to “gird up your loins”? How can we do this to our minds? Why are Christians told to be sober? (Verse 13)

2. How are Christians instructed to be like children in this context? Why can't we just be like everyone else around us? What does it mean to be “holy” and how can we tell if we are being “holy”? (Verses 14-16)

3. How do we call on the Father? Why is God's impartiality in judgment a good thing? How should we conduct ourselves during our “stay here”? (Verse 17)

4. What traditions had they received from their father and where had it lead them? What makes our redemption so valuable and enduring? (Verses 18-19)

5. What does it mean that Christ was “foreordained”? Why was He made manifest? How does verse 21 show how the gospel impacts our relationship with God? (Verses 20-21)

6. What impact does the word of God have upon the Christian? How do we come across the word of God? What verses are quoted in this text? (Verses 22-25)
