2. What is significant about loving Jesus even though we can't see Him? What type of joy are Christians supposed to have? What is meant by the “end of our faith”? (Verses 8-9)

3. How might the prophets the prophets inquired and searched about our salvation? What are some prophecies that talk about the grace that has come to us? (Verse 10)

4. What is meant by the phrase “the Spirit of Christ who was in them”?
(Verse 11)

5. When were these things revealed to the prophets? How have we heard
about them? (Verse 12)

6. What role did the Holy Spirit have in preaching the gospel? Why were these
things kept from the angels? (Verse 12)
