

## Questions for 1 Peter 1:1-5

1. What is the “Dispersion”? What areas was the apostle Peter writing to and where are they located? (Verse 1)

2. Discuss the doctrines of election and the foreknowledge of God. What is the Biblical view of these concepts and how has Calvinism distorted their rightful meanings? (Verse 2)

3. How are we sanctified by the Spirit? What is meant by the “sprinkling of the blood of Christ”? When does this occur to you and I and what is the imagery calling back to? (Verse 2)

4. How have we been “begotten again” and what is the connection between this and the resurrection of Jesus? What is our “living hope” that we have been begotten to? (Verse 3)

5. What does our inheritance consist of? Where is this inheritance kept? Why is it important to know where our inheritance is? (Verse 4)

6. Who is kept by the power of God? How are they kept and what are they kept from? Does this verse support the doctrine of Christians being, “Once saved, Always Saved”? (Verse 5)
