

Questions for 1 Peter 3:8-17

1. How can we be of “one mind” with our brothers and sisters in Christ? Define the terms, “love as brothers”, “tenderhearted”, and “courteous”. Why don’t we return evil or railings to our brethren? How are we called to this type of relationship with our brethren? (Verse 8-9)

2. What verses are being quoted here? Who do these verses apply to and how could they help relationships between brethren in Christ? (Verses 10-12)

3. Why is there no fear of harm for following what is good? Why is there blessing in suffering for righteousness? (Verses 13-14)

4. How do we sanctify the Lord God in our hearts? Why is it important to be ready to give an answer? How are we supposed to give our answers and why is it important? (Verse 15)

5. How do we have a good conscience? Why might it be God's will that we suffer? (Verses 16-17)
