

# Questions for 1 Samuel 10:1-27

1. A) Why is Saul anointed but then proclaimed to be king later? B) Why does Samuel go into such detail about the events that will happen to Saul? C) What do some of the locations tell us about the state of sacrifice and worship in Israel? (Verses 1-8)

2. A) What does it mean that the Lord “gave him another heart”? B) Did this mean that his personality changed and/or override his free will? C) What can we learn about there being a “company of prophets” and what might this tell us about the word of the Lord coming in these days versus the days of Eli? (Verses 9-12)

3. A) Where did Saul meet his uncle? B) Why didn't Saul tell his uncle about the kingdom? (Verses 13-16)

4. A) Why does Samuel go over the history of Israel before announcing their king? B) How was selecting a king a rejection of God when God had done all of these things to Saul so they could have a king? (Verses 17-19)

5. A) What does it say of Saul that he was hiding among the equipment when his name was called? B) Why were the people excited about Saul being their king? C) What did the book that Samuel wrote explain and why was it set before the Lord? D) Why did the rebels not bring any gifts? (Verses 20-27)
