3. A) What was the sign that Saul used to get the nation on board with the new monarchy? B) Why did Saul choose that particular sign? C) What happened to the people when they saw it? (Verses 7-8)

4. A) Describe the great victory that Saul orchestrated for Israel. B) Are there any similarities between what happened with this battle and others carried out by God's chosen leader? (Verses 9-11)

5. A) What did the people want to do after the battle? B) Why does Saul stop them from doing it and how does this highlight his leadership? C) Why did they renew Saul's kingship? (Verses 12-15)
