2. A) What are the wages of unrighteousness? B) What is the sin of “carousing”? C) What does it mean to be “spots and blemishes”? (Verse 13)

3. A) What are “eyes full of adultery”? B) Why can’t they cease from sin? C) How does one train their heart in covetous practices? D) What does it mean to be “accursed children”? (Verse 14)

4. A) Discuss the account of Balaam. B) How did Balaam go from a faithful prophet of God to an example of what a false teacher looks like? (Verses 15-16)

5. A) How do these analogies describe the disappointing nature of false teachers? B) What does the phrase “blackness of darkness” tell us about the judgement of hell? (Verse 17)
