2. A) Are the sinful angels what we understand demons to be? B) Have the sinful angels ever "gotten out"? C) What, if any, impact have the sinful angels had on humanity, both throughout history and today? (Verse 4)

3. A) Why did God destroy the ancient world? B) How was Noah's preaching a sign of God's mercy and long suffering? C) Why was it moral and ethical for God to take so much life, but it is not more and ethical for us to take life? (Verse 5)

4. A) Why did God destroy Sodom and Gomorrah? B) What sin in particular were they committing that led to their destruction? C) Where might Sodom and Gomorrah have been, geographically? (Verse 6)

5. A) Why was Lot delivered from Sodom? B) What lessons can we learn from Lot and the effect that Sodom had on his soul and his family? (Verses 7-8)

6. A) Why should God's acts of judgement and punishment be seen as sources of comfort for Christians? B) Why don't angels bring a reviling accusation against them? (Verses 9-11)
