2. A) How does being mindful of the words of the prophets and apostles help us understand the last days? B) Are scoffers still asking this question today? C) Why do they feel justified in walking according to their own lusts? (Verse 3-4)

3. A) Why would someone "willfully forget" important information? B) What example is used to explain how things are being preserved for future destruction in judgement? C) What are some comparisons and contrasts between the two events? (Verses 5-7)

4. A) What are some of the ways that this verse has been interpreted and used to interpret other biblical principles? B) How should it be used, contextually? (Verse 8)

5. A) What does the delay of judgement say about God's long-suffering? B) Why is God not willing that any should perish? C) Why does God require repentance from individuals in order to save them? (Verse 9)
