

## Questions for Deuteronomy 26:1-19

1. What was the basis, or motivating principle, for this offering? (verses 1-4)
2. Who was the “Syrian” (Aramean in other versions) and why was such a designation used to describe him? (verse 5)
3. What is the meaning of the expression that the Lord “looked on our affliction and our labor and our oppression?” (verses 5-11)

4. What were the three negative uses for the holy tithes? (verses 12-14)

5. Some passages in the Law of Moses reveal that God would dwell in the Tabernacle among Israel (Exodus 25:8; 29:45), yet here, God's habitation is said to be heaven. How are these concepts harmonized? (verse 15)

6. What is the significance of the repeated expressions "this day" or "today" used in this paragraph? (verses 16-19)
