1. What does the expression, “I can no longer go out and come in” mean? (verses 1-6)

2. What council did Moses give to Joshua? (verses 7-8)

3. Who had the responsibility of reading the law before the people and how was this accomplished? (verses 9-13)

4. Why was Joshua inaugurated (ordained) again here when it had already happened in Numbers 27:18-32? (verses 14-15; 23)

5. In addition to writing the law, what reminder was Moses to leave with the people concerning their responsibilities to the Lord? (verses 16-22)

6. Why was Moses convinced that the people would eventually rebel against God? (verses 24-30)
