1. What would be required of Israel for them to receive God's blessings which Moses described with the phrase: "that you may live?" (verses 1-2)
2. Why was the incident at Baal Peor so consequential that it was mentioned in this context? (verses 3-4)
3. How was Israel to show "in the sight of the peoples" that God was with them? (verses 5-8)

4. Why was it so important for this groups of people to learn of the events at Sinai? (verses 9-14)

5. What likeness was used for a carved image at Sinai, and what kinds of figures does Moses cite as commonly used sources for idolatry? (verses 15-20)

6. What does the phrase “God is a consuming fire, a jealous God” mean? (verses 21-24)
