3. What special and unique works did God perform for Israel? What was God's motivation for all He did for them? (verses 32-39)

4. God promised Israel the land “for all time.” Does this verse prove the theology taught by many denominations today that Christians should help modern Israelis retake the promised land? (verse 40)

5. Why insert these words regarding the cities of refuge in the midst of a sermon about the need for obedience and the dangers of idolatry? (verses 41-43)

6. Is there a significant difference between law, testimonies, statutes, and judgments? (verses 44-49)
