

## Questions for Deuteronomy 6:1-25

1. How do these verses provide a transition from the previous chapter? (verses 1-3)

2. Why is verse four often called the Shema? What did Jesus say about the command given in verse five? (verses 4-5)

3. What do the phrases “you shall bind them as a sign on your hand,” and “they shall be as frontlets between your eyes” mean? (verses 6-9)

4. How would God give them cities, houses, wells, and vineyards which required no work on their part to prepare? (verses 10-15)

5. What had the people done to tempt God at Massah? (verses 16-19)

6. How were Israelites to summarize the meaning of all that God commanded them? (verses 20-25)
