1. How did God want Israel to socially interact with the nations who dwelt in Canaan? (verses 1-5)

2. Of all the great tribes of the earth, why did God choose Israel to be His holy people? (verses 6-8)

3. What does the phrase, “He repays those who hate Him to their face” mean? (verses 9-11)

4. Do these verses teach that barrenness and sickness were always a result of personal sin? (verses 12-16)

5. Why was there concern about the “beasts of the field” becoming too numerous? (verses 17-24)

6. What were the “abominations” and “accursed” things and why was Israel forbidden from bringing them into their homes? (verses 25-26)
