

Questions for John 10:1-42

1. What is a sheepfold and what is it representing? Who are the thieves and strangers representing? Who are the sheep? What does it mean that the sheep “know his voice”? (Verses 1-6)

2. What does it mean for Jesus to be the door of the sheep? How do we enter in? What does it mean that they will go in and out and find pasture? (Verses 7-10)

3. What does it mean for Jesus to be the good shepherd? What is a hireling and how do they bring harm to the sheep? (Verses 11-15)

4. What are the “other” sheep that Jesus is referring to? Why is it significant that Jesus laid down his life and took it again? (Verses 16-18)

5. What is the Feast of Dedication? Why did they ask Jesus to tell them plainly who He was? What was Jesus’ response? How did they react? (Verses 19-33)

6. What passage is Jesus quoting from? What is the meaning of the phrase, “You are gods”? How did this condemn their actions against Jesus? How did John the Baptist continue to influence the crowds? (Verses 34-42)
