

Questions for Jude 1:5-9

1. A) How does the example of Israel's deliverance from Egypt illustrate God's judgement against false teachers? (Verse 5)

2. A) How does the judgement against the fallen angels illustrate God's judgement against false teachers? B) How does this verse help our understanding of the fallen angels when compared with 2 Peter 2:4? (Verse 6)

3. A) How does the judgement against Sodom and Gomorrah illustrate God's judgement against false teachers? B) Why are these individuals referred to as "dreamers" in the NKJV? C) How were the false teachers of Jude's day similar to the evil ones in the previous 3 examples? (Verses 7-8)

4. A) What is the message that verse 9 is trying to teach Jude's audience about dealing with evil people? B) Why was Michael contending with the devil? C) What might this contention tell us about warfare in the spiritual realm? (Verse 9)

5. A) Why were they disputing over the body of Moses? B) Why did Michael not bring a railing accusation against him? (Verse 9)
