

Questions for Judges 18:1-31

1. What was the inheritance of the Danites supposed to be and why hadn't they received their inheritance yet? Where were they living at? Why did they recognize Micah's priest? What does their request for him to inquire of God say about their spiritual knowledge and state? (Verses 1-6)

2. Where is the city of Laish (later known as Dan)? Why do they decide to go and conquer this peaceful place and people? Why are they concerned about their ties to the Sidonians? (Verses 7-13)

3. Why did the spies want their brethren to consider the house of Micah? Why did they steal all the "worship items"? (Verses 14-17)

4. What do the Danites promise to the young Levite priest? Why was the priest so eager to turn his back on Micah? (Verses 18-20)

5. What does Micah do in response to their thievery? How do the Danites treat Micah when he catches up to them? (Verses 21-26)

6. What can we say about the morality of the actions of the Danites on the city of Laish? Who is Jonathan, the Son of Gershom, the Son of *Manasseh*? Why is the history of the idolatry of the Danites recorded for us, and what spiritual lessons should be learned from it? (Verses 27-31)
