

Questions for Matthew 5:13-16

1. Who is the salt of the earth and the light of the world? Is Jesus referring solely to his immediate audience, the Jews, Christians, or perhaps some other group? (verse 13-14)
2. How does salt lose its savor? (verse 13)
3. Are there any consequences of being a light to the world, according to John 3:19-21 (verses 14)

4. What is the Biblical significance of the righteous people of God being compared to a city? (verses 14)

5. What is the Biblical significance of the righteous people of God being compared to a candlestick? (verse 15)

6. Is it possible to be a faithful Christian in secret? (verses 15-16)
