

Questions for 1 John 2:1-14

1. Can a Christian fall to sin? If so, can that sin be forgiven? What does it mean that Jesus is our Advocate with the Father? (Verse 1)

2. What does it mean that Jesus is the “propitiation” of our sins? How can Jesus be the propitiation for the whole world? Does this verse teach universalism? (Verse 2)

3. How can we tell if we “know him” or not? What is the consequence of saying we know him and not keeping His commandments? How should we walk if we abide in Him? (Verse 3-6)

4. What is the old commandment and what is the new commandment that John is referring to? (Verses 7-8)

5. How does our relationship with our brethren affect our walk in the light? (Verses 9-11)

6. Why is John writing to the fathers, young men, and little children? What is written to each group? Why does John want them to know these things? (Verses 12-14)
