3. A) Who's advice to Rehoboam listen to? B) What was Israel's response? C) What happened to Adoram? (Verses 12-19)

4. A) What happened to Jeroboam after the rebellion? B) What was Rehoboam preparing to do? C) What happens instead? (Verses 20-24)

5. A) What plan does Jeroboam come up with, despite God's promises to him? B) What are the specific problems that are mentioned about Jeroboam's plan that goes against God's clear instructions? C) What should this tell us about God's expectations for worship? (Verses 25-33)
