1. A) What should the suffering of Christ inspire us to do? B) What does it look like to live for the lusts of men? C) What does it look like to live for the will of God? (Verses 1-2)

2. A) Why does Peter remind them of the things they used to do in their past “life-times”? B) Why are these sins discussed and are these things we deal with today? C) Why does God condemn these actions if they bring people happiness? (Verses 3-5)

3. A) How is the gospel preached to those who are dead? B) How are they judged according to men, but live according to God in the spirit? (Verse 6)

4. A) Why are they told that the end of all things is near when the end of all things hasn't happened yet? B) What are they supposed to do to prepare for the end? C) How does love cover a multitude of sins from the perspective of loving our brethren? (Verses 7-8)

5. A) Why is hospitality a vital part of Christian living? B) Why are we instructed to do it without grumbling? (Verse 9)

6. A) What type of gifts are being described in these verses? B) How do we speak as the oracles of God? C) What does it mean to minister with the ability that God supplies? (Verses 10-11)
