3. A) Why did David send his men to Nabal? B) What was Nabal's response to David? C) Why was David going to war against Nabal? (Verses 4-13)

4. A) Why did the young man come to Abigail? B) What does the young man say about the character of David and his men? C) What did Abigail do in response? (Verses 14-22)

5. A) What is Abigail's plea to David? B) What are some things that display her faith? C) What are some things that display her understanding of who David was going to be? (Verses 23-31)

6. A) Why does David listen to Abigail? B) What happens to Nabal? C) What is significant about Abigail becoming David's wife? (Verses 32-44)
