3. A) How did Amasa fail David? B) What did Joab do to Amasa and why did he do it? C) What did the other soldiers do? (Verses 4-13)

4. A) How does the wise woman help Joab defeat Sheba's revolt? (Verses 14-22)

5. A) Why does David keep letting Joab be the commander of the army even though he keeps killing people and defying his orders? B) Are there any significant details in David's government officers that are worth mentioning? (Verses 23-26)
