2. A) What does David describe the Lord doing when one of His children is in trouble? B) Can we be saved like David even when we don't see the same miracles today? (Verses 5-20)

3. A) How does the Lord treat those who are faithful to Him? (Verses 21-31)

4. A) What can the Lord enable us to do? B) How can we have more confidence in what the Lord can do for us? (Verses 32-37)

5. A) How can we give God the praise for everything that happens in our lives as David does here? B) Why did God deliver David from His enemies? (Verses 38-46)

6. A) How does David end this song? B) What are some things that we can add into our prayer life and daily mindset from this song of David? (Verses 47-51)
