

Questions for 2 Samuel 7:1-29

1. A) What prompted David to want to build a house for God? B) What does Nathan the prophet say about this? (Verses 1-3)

2. A) Why did the Lord intervene in the plans of David? B) According to the Lord, why wasn't there a temple built prior to David? (Verses 4-7)

3. A) What does the Lord promise to do for Israel? B) What does He promise to do for David at the end of verse 11? (Verses 8-11)

4. A) Who was going to build a house for the Lord and why? (1 Chronicles 28:2-3) B) Discuss the significance of this promise by God to establish the throne of David forever and how it impacts Christianity. (Verses 12-17)

5. A) In David's Thanksgiving with God's promise, how does David view himself and how does he view God? (Verses 18-24)

6. A) David accepts the blessing and promise that the Lord had given him. What are some practical applications that we can learn as Christians from David's attitude? (Verses 25-29)
