1. What exactly did this, the new generation of Israel, witness with their own eyes? (verses 1-7)

2. How was the land of Canaan different than Egypt? (verses 8-12)

3. What is “the early rain and the latter rain” and how did it help Israel’s farming? How was this expression figuratively used elsewhere in Scripture? (verses 13-17)

4. What does the phrase, “like the days of the heavens above the earth,” mean? (verses 18-21)

5. What was the ancient significance of setting one’s foot on the land? (verses 22-25)

6. When did the events referenced in this paragraph transpire? What is the purpose of laying out, in a physical demonstration, the blessings and curses? (verses 26-32)
