

## Questions for Deuteronomy 13 & 14

1. What message from an individual claiming to be a prophet would immediately give away that this was a test from the Lord? Why was such a harsh punishment necessary for the individual in these circumstances? (verses 1-5)

2. How were Israelites to react to those who were close to them suggesting to “go and serve other gods?” (verses 6-11)

3. What was supposed to happen to cities when apostasy had overtaken them? (verses 12-18)

4. What did cutting oneself or shaving the front of the head have to do with being a holy, special people? (verses 1-2)

5. What food principles are taught in this chapter? (verses 3-21)

6. How did God ensure that travel to the Tabernacle was not too burdensome on the people? (verses 22-29)
