

Questions for Deuteronomy 1:1-46

1. How did Moses begin his first speech to the people of Israel? (verses 1-8)
2. Why did Moses need to establish judges and how did he go about doing that? (verses 9-18)
3. Why were spies sent into Canaan? What did they discover? (verses 19-25)

4. Why did Moses say to Israel, “**you** would not go up” and “**you** complained in your tents” when they were not the ones who grumbled and refused to take the land, rather it was the previous generation? (verses 26-33)

5. When describing the little ones and children, Moses said they “have no knowledge of good and evil.” What does this expression mean? (verses 34-40)

6. If the Israelites realized their sin and repented, desiring now to combat their enemies, why did God refuse to go with them? (verses 41-46)
