2. What is being prohibited in this verse? (verse 5)

3. How is this law similar to the one found in Leviticus 22:27-28? What is the underlying principle at work? (verses 6-7)

4. What were “parapets” and why did Israelite rooftops need them? (verse 8)

5. How were these laws of separation intended to help Israel better understand the world and their place in it? (verses 9-11)

6. What lesson can be drawn from this verse and one similar to it in Numbers 15:37-41? (verse 12)
