2. What does the phrase “flee before you seven ways” mean? (verses 7-9)

3. Why is it significant that Israel would “lend to many nations” but not have to borrow? (verses 10-14)

4. How would Israel be punished for disobedience? What does the phrase “your heavens which are over your head shall be bronze, and the earth which is under you shall be iron” mean? (verses 15-24)

5. What is the dominant theme of these cruises? (verses 25-37)

6. What would be the end result of rebelling against the Lord? (verses 38-46)
