2. Why was the language describing the siege so graphic? (verses 52-57)

3. Why was Israel told to fear the “glorious and awesome **name**” of the Lord as opposed to fearing the Lord Himself? (verse 58)

4. What Abrahamic promise would be undone if Israel did not carefully observe the law? (verses 59-63)

5. Why was it significant that Israel would serve other gods while scattered in captivity? (verse 64)

6. What picture of the ultimate reversal of all that God had done is painted at the end of this chapter? (verses 65-68)
