3. What did Moses mean when he said, “the word *is* very near you,” and why was that an important message for the people? (verses 11-14)

4. What options had Moses presented to the nation? (verses 15-16)

5. How would “heaven and earth” be called as witnesses against Israel? (verses 17-19)

6. In what way are the three verbs: “love,” “obey,” and “cling” connected? (verse 20)
