

Questions for Deuteronomy 3:1-29

1. Why was it necessary for Israel to utterly destroy all the inhabitants of the kingdom of Og? (verses 1-7)

2. Based on the dimensions given for Og's iron bedstead, approximately how tall was this giant? (verses 8-11)

3. How was the territory east of the Jordan divided between the tribes of Reuben, Gad, and half of Manasseh? (verses 12-17)

4. If God wanted Israel to be a unified people who worked together towards common goals, why divide them into tribes with separate territories? (verses 18-20)

5. In a speech addressing all the people, why single out the encouragement provided to Joshua? (verses 21-22 & 28)

6. What great plea did Moses make before the Lord? (verses 23-29)
