

Questions for Deuteronomy 9:1-29

1. What did the righteousness of the people of Israel have to do with their conquering of Canaan? (verses 1-6)
2. Why did Moses fast during the forty days he spent on the mountain with the Lord? What is the general purpose of fasting? (verses 7-12)
3. What was God going to do to the people after the Golden Calf incident? How did Moses intercede? (verses 13-21)

4. What events transpired at Taberah, Massah, and Kibroth Hattaavah? (verse 22)

5. What does the phrase “you have been rebellious against the Lord from the day that I knew you” mean? To what might Moses be referring? (verses 23-24)

6. How was Moses concerned about the way people might view God? (verses 25-29)
