

Questions for John 12:20-50

1. Why were Greeks present at a Jewish feast? Why did they want to see Jesus? What was Jesus' answer to this request? Did Jesus' response answer their question? (Verses 20-26)

2. Why was Jesus troubled? What is the "hour" that Jesus is referencing? Why did God speak from heaven and what impact did it have? (Verses 27-30)

3. How was the world judged? Who is the ruler of this world and how was he cast out? How was Jesus able to draw all people unto Himself by being lifted up? (Verses 31-33)

4. What scripture might the people have been referring to that says that the Christ would remain forever? Why does Jesus not answer their question directly, instead responding about walking will they have light? What scripture was fulfilled in them? (Verses 34-38)

5. What does it mean that they “could not believe” because of the prophecy in Isaiah 6? Why were there people that did believe on Jesus, but didn’t confess it? (Verses 39-43)

6. Why is it essential to know that believing on Jesus means believing on the Father? Why did Jesus say that he was not going to judge those who reject Him and do not receive His words? What is it that will judge us in the last day? (Verses 44-50)
