

Questions for John 17:1-26

1. To whom has the Father given to have eternal life (verse 2)? What is required to have eternal life? Why did Jesus say that He had finished the work when he hadn't died on the cross yet? What glory did Jesus have before the world was? (Verses 1-5)

2. How did God manifest the Father to the disciples? In what way did the disciples belong to the Father, such that they the Father gave them to Jesus? (Verses 6-8)

3. Why did Jesus pray for the disciples but not for the world? How did Jesus "keep" the disciples? Who is the son of perdition and what scripture is fulfilled that he would be lost? (Verses 9-12)

4. How would the disciples have Christ's joy fulfilled in themselves? Why did Jesus ask that they would not be taken out of the world? What applications could we apply to ourselves from this statement? How were Jesus and the disciples sanctified? (Verses 13-19)

5. To what group does the Lord's prayer turn to? What was the prayer of Christ for them in his final hours before the cross? What comfort should this give us? (Verses 20-23)

6. Why did Jesus desire for the disciples to be with Him? What was one of the reasons that Jesus would continue to declare the name of the Father? (Verses 24-26)
