

## Questions for John 3:17-36

1. Why did God send His Son into the world? Why is this point one of the most important to remember? (Verse 17)

2. What is the condemnation? How can we tell if we are of the darkness or of the light? How might these verses relate to John's introduction in chapter 1:5-14? (Verses 18-21)

3. Did Jesus baptize anyone? Why did John baptize where he did and what does might this tell us about how baptism is performed? (Verses 22-24)

4. How does John the Baptist describe his role now that the Messiah has been revealed? How does John's reaction to their question reaffirm his original witness of Jesus? (Verses 25-30)

5. Why was Jesus' testimony more important than John's? Why did John say that no one receives the testimony of Jesus? What does receiving the testimony of Jesus prove and can this be proved in any other way? (Verses 31-33)

6. What does it mean that God does not give the Spirit by measure? How does John's words mirror and/or differ from Jesus' words earlier in the chapter? (Verses 34-36)
