

Questions for John 5:30-47

1. What is the connection between Jesus not seeking His own will and the need for witnesses? Why couldn't Jesus bear witness of himself? Why was it important for Jesus to have multiple witnesses? (Verses 30-31)

2. Who was one of Jesus' prime witnesses? Did Jesus need the witness of John? Why was John the Baptist used as a witness of Christ? (Verses 32-35)

3. What were the second and third witness of Jesus' divinity? How did these witnesses manifest Jesus' divinity? (Verses 36-37)

4. What is the fourth witness of Jesus' divinity? Is this witness the most enduring of the others? How can we use this witness today? (Verses 38-39)

5. How could Jesus tell that the ones to whom He was addressing did not have the love of God in them? What hypocrisies does Jesus accuse them of? Why does Jesus make sure to say that He did not receive honor or testimony from man? (Verses 40-44)

6. Who was the one accuser that the Jews had against them? What makes his accusation so significant? (Verses 45-47)
