

Questions for John 6:1-21

1. When are these events taking place in the ministry of Christ? (Verses 1-4)

2. Why did Jesus ask Philip where they could buy bread? Why did Jesus want to feed the multitudes? (Verses 5-6)

3. How large was this crowd? How much money would it have taken to feed them? Are there any lessons to be learned from the boy that came with 5 loaves and two fish? (Verses 7-10)

4. Why might Jesus have chosen to multiply the loaves and fish as opposed to creating food from nothing? What are some lessons to be learned from this miracle? (Verses 11-14)

5. Why did they want to make Jesus their king? Why didn't Jesus accept the role being thrust upon Him? (Verse 15)

6. What can we learn about Jesus from walking on the water in this account? (Verses 16-21)
