

Questions for John 6:41-71

1. Why did the Jews complain about what Jesus had said? How does the Father draw people to Jesus? (Verses 41-45)

2. How can someone “see” the Father? What are the similarities between Jesus, the bread of life, and the manna that fell from heaven under Moses? (Verses 46-51)

3. How do we “consume” the bread of life? What sort of communion is Jesus describing? Are these verses talking about the Lord’s supper? Why or why not? (Verses 52-58)

4. Why did many of the disciples stop following Jesus after this saying? Jesus had said hard things before, so what was different about this one? (Verses 59-60, 66)

5. Why did the disciples of Jesus have a difficult time understanding the sayings of Jesus? (Verses 61-65)

6. What made the 12 different from the rest of the disciples? Why did Jesus choose Judas knowing what He would do to Him later? (Verses 66-71)
