

Questions for John 9:1-41

1. Why might the disciples assume sin was involved when one was born blind? What did Jesus say was the reason he was born this way? How did Jesus heal him? (Verses 1-7)

2. Why were the people confused about this man's identity? Why was there a division among the Jews about Jesus after this miracle? What did the blind man initially believe about Jesus? (Verses 8-17)

3. Why did the Jews call for the blind man's parents? What was their response to the questions from the Jews? What lessons might we learn from their lack of support towards their son? (Verses 18-23)

4. How did they try to discredit Jesus this time? How did the former blind man respond? Does his logic typify how Jesus expected the people to come to the conclusion that He was from God? (Verses 24-33)

5. Why did they feel that they could ignore his sound logical argument? Why might Jesus have chosen to have another interaction with him? How does this man's attitude compare with others that Jesus healed? (Verses 34-38)

6. How is judgement executed by causing some to see and others to be blind? Why does Jesus say the blind have no sin? What is this referring to? (Verses 39-41)
