

# Questions for Judges 10:1-18

1. What can we learn about Tola and his time judging Israel? Why might there be so little recorded about him? (Verses 1-2)

2. What can learn about Jair and his time judging Israel? Why are Jair's sons significant? (Verses 3-5)

3. What did the children of Israel do after Jair died? Why did God stop sending judges in direct succession of each other if that kept them from falling to idolatry? (Verses 6-9)

4. How was God communicating with Israel? Why did God say that He wasn't going to deliver them anymore? What did God tell the children of Israel to do instead? (Verses 10-14)

5. What does it say of the children of Israel that they put away their false gods and served the Lord, even when He said he wouldn't deliver them anymore? Should our motivation for serving God be tied to what we can or do receive from Him? What does it mean that God's "soul" could no longer endure the misery of Israel? (Verses 15-16)

6. Why didn't the people of Israel begin to attack when they had their armies assembled? What were they waiting for? (Verses 17-18)
