

Questions for Matthew 20:1-19

1. Who do the householder and the laborers represent? What is the wage that is agreed upon representing? (Verses 1-2)

2. Who is represented by those standing in the marketplace throughout the day? (Verses 3-7)

3. Who are the ones that were murmuring, as it applies to the kingdom of heaven? Why were they murmuring? (Verses 8-12)

4. Why is it fair for the workers to all receive the same wage, even if they work different amounts of time. Does this show favoritism from the goodman of the house? (Verses 13-15)

5. How does this parable display the concept that the first will be last? Why will few be chosen? (Verse 16)

6. How close are the events of the crucifixion from happening? (Verses 17-19)
