

Questions for Matthew 13:24-43

1. Why would an enemy sow tares in a field of good seed? How could they know that this was an enemy? (Verses 24-28)

2. What is the reasoning for leaving the tares in with the good seed? Is it spiritually healthy to be isolated with only Christians, such as communal living? (Verses 28-30)

3. How is the church like a mustard seed? (Verses 31-32)

4. How is the church like leaven? (Verse 33-35)

5. Are people predestined to be either good seed or tares according to this parable? Can you change what you are? (Verses 36-38)

6. Why is this a good parable to combat premillennialism? (Verses 37-43)
