1. What are some aspects of a child's mindset that are useful and essential for Christians to have? (Verses 1-4)

2. Who are the "little children" and "little ones" that Jesus is referring to? Are these actual children or a reference to those that are young and vulnerable in the faith? (Verses 5-6)

3. In this context, what does it mean to offend, or cause offenses? What is the danger in doing so? (Verses 6-9)

4. Why must offenses come? (Verse 7)

5. What can we learn about the angels of the little ones that are in the presence of God in heaven? (Verse 10)

6. What are some lessons that we can learn from the analogy of the one lost sheep that was found? (Verses 11-14)
