

Questions for Matthew 21:1-22

1. What prophecy did this fulfill? What is the significance and symbolism associated with royalty and the donkey? (Verses 1-6)

2. Why did the people make such a show of adoration when Jesus came into the city of Jerusalem? (Verses 7-11)

3. Was Jesus angry when he drove out all the thieves in the temple? What should we learn from this example? (Verses 12-13)

4. Why were the chief priests and scribes upset with the crowds? Why does perfected praise come out of the mouths of babes? (Verses 14-16)

5. What was Jesus trying to prove by his interaction with the fig tree? Was he simply mad that there was nothing on it, or was there some larger significance? (Verses 17-19)

6. According to Jesus here, what is the connection between faith, having no doubt, and prayer? Will we literally receive anything we ask if we pray for it? (Verses 20-22)
