

Questions for Matthew 22:1-14

1. What does the wedding feast represent? (Verses 1-3)

2. Who are the guests? Why did the guests not come to the feast? What is this representing? (Verses 3-6)

3. What events could be represented by the king destroying the murderers? (Verses 7-8)

4. What events is the calling of the random people to the feast? What is meant by good and bad guests? (Verses 8-10)

5. Who is the guest without a wedding garment representing? Why isn't he wearing a wedding garment? What does the wedding garment represent? (Verses 11-14)

6. What is the punishment for the man without a wedding garment? Why is this description of hell real and not part of the parable? (Verses 13-14)
