

Questions for Matthew 24:36-51

1. Is Jesus talking about a different “coming of the Son of Man” starting in verse 36, or is this a continuation of the description of the destruction of Jerusalem? (Verses 36-37)

2. How will the coming of the Son of Man be comparable to Noah and the flood? (Verses 37-39)

3. What does it mean that one shall be taken and the other left? Does this verse teach the rapture? (Verses 40-41)

4. Why is the coming of the Son of Man going to be so unexpected? Why are there not more signs given like there were with the destruction of Jerusalem? (Verses 42-44)

5. What are some lessons that we can learn from the prepared and unprepared servants? (Verses 45-51)

6. How can we know for sure that we are prepared for the coming of the Son of Man? (Verses 42-51)
