

## Questions for Matthew 26:26-30

1. How do we know that Jesus and the disciples were using unleavened bread and unfermented wine? (Verse 26)

2. How did Jesus break the bread? Is this significant? (Verse 26)

3. What does the bread and fruit of the vine represent? Do these items become literally the flesh and blood of Jesus? (Verse 26-28)

4. From this passage alone, could we say that Jesus only used one cup? Does it matter if Jesus did? Does the cup have significance? (Verses 27-28)

5. What did Jesus mean when He said that He would not drink of the fruit of the vine until he drank it new in His Father's kingdom? (Verse 29)

6. Are elements of this last supper, such as the fact that it happened at night or that they sang a hymn after, essential to include in the observance of the Lord's supper? Why or why not? (Verse 30)
